Conditions and Rules for OSCOV Show 2011
Please read carefully before entering plants in this show.

1. Set up times for 2011: Wed. 9:00am – 4:30pm
2. Financial members of any invited orchid society and invited traders are free to enter. Each society is entitled to set up only one display which may be a theme display. No stand backdrop may be taller than 1.8m unless against an outside wall. Backdrops must be free standing. Individuals may exhibit on more than one display.
3. All orchids exhibited must have been owned and grown by the exhibitor for at least six months.
4. **Each person entering a plant/s must** register their name and receive an exhibitor **NUMBER and exhibitor PASS. Early registration may be made via Meryl Early, Ph. 03 9786 1938.** All plants exhibited for judging should be clearly labeled with the correct name of the plant, accurately spelled and the exhibitor number on the **bottom left hand corner** of the label. Labels must enable Judges to distinguish between similar plants exhibited by a grower. Please ensure that all labels are clearly visible for judging.
5. For **each Notifiable** class a Notifiable sheet must be completed and returned. The appropriate **coloured spot/s**, available at the Registration Desk, must be placed on the **lower right hand corner of the label.**
Please return Notifiable Plant Sheets to the Registration Desk as soon as possible and no later than 4.30 pm WEDNESDAY
6. **Mistakes in labeling of plants may result in the plant not being judged.** If you have any problems please ask for assistance at the Registration Desk.
7. No person is permitted to handle or remove any plant or flower before close on Sunday without the permission of the Show Marshal or Registrar of Judges.
8. In all matters related to judging the judges' decision will be final. First and Second places will be awarded in all classes, except in those in which the Judges consider the exhibit(s) do not meet the desired standard.
9. Where sufficient numbers of plants are presented, and an appropriate class is not listed in the schedule, then extra classes may be created by the Judges with the Show Marshal's approval.
10. The Judging Registrar will be an Orchid Societies Council of Victoria Accredited Judge and the show will be judged according to OSCOV judging rules. Any accredited Australian or International Judge is welcome to request in advance to be part of the Judging Panel.
11. The Show Marshal or Judging Panel may remove any plant suspected of being diseased or unhealthy.
12. The award of a first prize in an open class to a Junior grower will not affect their current status. Where an appropriate class is not available in their Section, e.g., Seedling, then they may nominate without prejudice to their status.
13. OSCOV will take every care with exhibitors' plants and displays, but does not accept responsibility for the loss, theft or damage to any plant or theme materials.
14. By entering plants in this show exhibitors agree to be bound by these rules and all decisions made by the Judges, Show Marshal and Show Co-ordinators.
15. OSCOV reserves the right to photograph any exhibit or display in the show and to reproduce and publish these photographs.
16. Society displays may contain plants from Commercial Growers, provided these plants are appropriately identified as such and that the display has a greater proportion of plants from other members. Coloured dots are available from the registration desk.
17. The Show Marshal (or his or her delegate for this purpose) has sole responsibility to determine the classification of an exhibitor as Commercial or Non-commercial, but he or she may consult with the exhibitor before making that determination.
